For the Week of January 15-21, 2018

Read: "Jesus Cleanses the Temple" (John

Recite: "Jesus answered them, 'Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."— John 2:19

Reflect: Jesus was in the Holy City of Jerusalem one day and visited the Temple, only to discover that people were not taking good care of the temple. He responds to what he sees with a level of violence not seen very often — shouting at the top of his lungs, scaring off the animals and overturning the tables of the moneychangers. What one word or phrase would you use to describe what Jesus was feeling that day? Does it shock you to know that at least on occasion Jesus felt that way and acted on his feelings? What sorts of things do you see out and about in the world that make you feel the way that Jesus felt there in the Temple? How might you act upon those feelings in a way that is good for the Kingdom of God?

Pray: God of the Temple— Help us to remember that you are indeed the Lord of the church but you are also the Lord of our hearts. Help us to remember that you died and three days later, you were raised from the dead. Dwell within us and like you promised, never leave us. Amen.
