Bible Reading for the For the Week of April 2-8, 2018

**Read:** "Thomas" (John 20:19-31)

**Recite:** "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." — John:20:29

**Reflect:** Jesus appears to the disciples after being raised from the dead. They touched his scars on his hands and on his side. And Jesus invites them not to doubt but believe. Think of a time in your life when you were 'of strong faith'. What about that time encouraged your faith?. Then think of a time in your life when you were more like 'doubting Thomas'. What about that situation exacerbated your doubts and questions? Finally think of someone who struggles and doubts about faith. Find a way to share the love of Jesus with them by baking them cookies, writing them a note, or by going for a walk with them. Actions often speak louder than words.

**Pray:** Promising God — You are with us when things are going great. You are with us when things are not. You are with us when we believe in faith. And you are with us when we doubt. Thank you for your promise to love us in the midst of every life situation and every emotion which we feel. Amen.
