Read: "Paul and Silas" (Acts 16:16-34)

Recite: "Then he brought them outside and said, 'Sirs, what must I do to be saved?' Paul and Silas answered, 'Believe on the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." — Acts 16:30-31

Reflect: Paul and Silas are imprisoned for believing in Jesus. While there, they sing their way through an earthquake. The jailer, who scared for his life, learns about the love of Jesus from Paul. Who taught you about Jesus? Whom do you have opportunity to tell about Jesus?
