Bible Reading for the For the Week of April 9-15, 2018

Read: "Paul's Conversion" (Acts 9:1-19)

Recite: "[Saul] asked, 'Who are you, Lord?' The reply came, 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.' " -Acts 9:5

Reflect: Saul had been a leader among those who were seeking to shut down the Jesus movement - both in Jerusalem and abroad. But Jesus appeared to him and asked him to stop. Jesus changed Saul's heart. His motivation for ministry was to change from one based on hate and fear to one based on love, forgiveness and acceptance. Name one thing you wish Jesus would change in your heart.
