Bible Reading for the For the Week of May 7-13, 2018

Read: "The Christ Hymn" (Philippians 2:1-13)

Recite: "He humbled himself and became obedient to the point of deatheven death on a cross." - Philippians 2:8

Reflect: At the heart of this week's reading is an early hymn of the Christian community – a piece traditionally known as "the Christ Hymn" - Philippians 2:6-11. It celebrates the humility of Jesus, and invites us to share in that same value. (In fact, 'humility' was the overarching value by which the early Christians strove to define their lives!) What does 'humility' look like in our world today? Have you ever met someone who is truly numbered among the humble? What might a dose of humility look like in your own life?

Pray: God, you are the Master Potter. Make us and mold us to continue to hold on to our faith, even when people come against us and when things look impossible. Amen.
