From Rancho Santa Marta - Rod & Tina's Corner

Sometimes in ministry or for that case in any job you are so involved in the work that you forget the reason or the vision of that work. We were at that point at the ranch. We are focused on school, teachers, students, construction, groups, house parents that we forgot about the kids and the reason why they are here. We received a call from social services asking if we would take on a family, two brothers at seven and five years old and a three year old sister. We only had room for one of the boys, but we made room for both and the sister because we do not believe in separating families. We picked them up from the social services office and we were not welcomed by the boys at all. They were defiant and would not give us a handshake...at first. After five minutes the oldest came up and and then came the middle brother. The little three-year-old was outgoing and warmed up to us right away. These three precious children were on their second tour with DIF (Children social services in Mexico). Of course they are going to be angry. They want to be with their family! All three slept on the way down to the ranch and it just made us sad that these three children would have to go through this experience but it made us realize this is why Rancho Santa Marta exists. We are able to provide a home for these children even though
