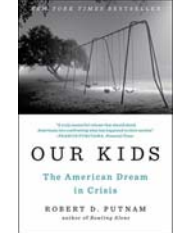
**Please note office hours are Monday - Thursday, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Even though there may be people on the property, there is no one in the office to help or answer questions.
