For Next Week – Sunday, September 30


Read: "Rescue at the Sea" (*Exodus 14:5-31*)

Recite: "Moses said to the people, 'Do not be afraid, stand firm, and see the deliverance that the LORD will accomplish for you.'" *Exodus 14:13*

Reflect:

- The Books of Genesis and Exodus recount numerous places where water is the instrument of death and life and purification. Consider the story of Noah and the Ark in Genesis 6-9. Consider the story of the birth of Moses in Exodus 1-2. Can you think of any other biblical stories that use water as God's instrument of death, life and/or purification?
- Have you ever experienced being rescued? What – to you – does rescue look like? What does it feel like? How did you / would you react when someone rescues you? How did God's people react when they were rescued at the Red Sea?
- In Exodus 15, Moses' sister Miriam sings a song about what happened to/for them at the Red Sea. If you were to write a song about what good things God does in your life, what would you include?

Pray: God, you guide our paths. We might not have seen the kind of power on display at the shores of the Red Sea. But, we have seen the kind of love you have displayed in Jesus. Help us to see your love in our lives. Help us to be that love for others. Amen.
