Read: "Renewing the Covenant" (Joshua 24:1-24)

Recite: "Joshua said to the

Children of Israel ... 'As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."— Joshua 24:15

Reflect:

- Joshua talks about making commitments for whole households. Our own congregation's Mission Statement – Building Up Households of Faith – is grounded in this very idea. Have you been blessed in your life by the faith commitment of anyone else in your household? How might you extend that blessing to others in your household?
- Sometimes people have decorations in their house that indicate what Joshua says in this week's reading: "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." (Joshua 24:15) It might be a cross or a picture or even Joshua's very words. Is there anything in your house that points to Joshua's words or reminds you of your faith commitments?
