For the Week of April 7, 2019

Read: "Last Judgment" (Matthew 25:31-46)

Recite: In his parable, Jesus said, "...Truly I tell you,

just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me."—Matthew 25:40

Reflect:

- Consider a time when serving or helping someone out was particularly meaningful to you. Who did you help? How did that feel? Were you expecting to help that person out? Or was it more of a surprise?
- What are things that get in the way of our serving and helping? What causes us to overlook those who are in need? What makes us refuse to help? What can you do to push back against those things?
- Jesus' parable about the sheep and goats has a clear invitation to serve and to see Jesus in the lives of those we serve. Be on the lookout for spontaneous opportunities to serve, both around the house and in your daily life!

Pray: Lord God, Heavenly King—thank you for including us as your sheep. Help us always to see you in others, especially when we meet people who are in need. Remind us that when we serve those who are in need, we are serving you. Amen.


