For the Week of April 14, 2019 *Read:* "Triumphal Entry"

(Matthew 21:1-14)

Recite: The crowds that went ahead of him and that

followed were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"— *Matthew 21:9*

Reflect:

- When Jesus enters Jerusalem, the scene looks a bit like a parade for a victorious military hero. In what ways was this scene all wrong for Jesus? In what ways was this scene completely right for Jesus?
- Our reading this week contains multiple answers to the question "Who IS this Jesus?" The crowd has one answer – the money changers another – the chief priests another – the blind and lame yet another. (It's as though the question that has lingered throughout the gospel about the identity of Jesus is coming to its crescendo.) And it begs of each of us our own answer to that question: "Who IS this Jesus?" Who is Jesus to you today?

Pray: Lord God, Heavenly King—the crowds welcomed your Son as a conquering hero, without even suspecting that he would soon conquer sin and death. Help us to sing Jesus' praises daily in our lives and to welcome him as our Lord and Savior. Amen.




