Read: "Gospel as

Recite: "For I am not ashamed of the gospel; it is

the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed — Romans 1:16-17a

Reflect:

- Paul tells the Christians in Rome that he prays for them; that he gives thanks to God for them; and that he is eager to visit them so that they both might be encouraged by one another's faith. For whom would you like to give thanks? Whom would you like to pray for? Whom would you like to encourage? From whom would you like to hear a word of encouragement?
- People don't write or send letters as much as they used to. Talk about other ways people communicate with each other across distances in addition to letters. What are some good things about some of these new ways of communicating? Are there any drawbacks? Is there anything you can think of that might make letter writing better than electronic communication?
- The Roman Christians cherished this letter which Paul had written them. Why don't you write a letter, note, or send a card to someone you know needs encouragement!

Pray: God of all humanity, you welcomed all – sinners and saints – into your kingdom. Help us to be as welcoming and accepting as you. We pray these things in the name of Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. Amen.


