

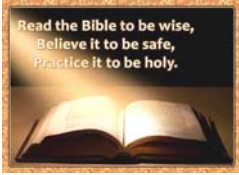

Read: “God’s Love
 Poured Out” (*Romans 5:1-11*)

Recite: The apostle Paul wrote, “God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.” — *Romans 5:8*

Reflect:

- Can you recall a time in your life when you experienced inordinate suffering? How did things like endurance, character, hope, and love reveal themselves to you amid that experience?
- Have you ever been in a position to do something nice, kind, or helpful for someone you didn’t like or for someone who had previously done you wrong? What might have been some good reasons for doing that positive thing for that someone? What might have held you back from doing such? What does Paul say about God’s love for us in *Romans 5:8*?

Pray: Merciful Father, it really is amazing grace: you didn’t wait for humanity to get its act together. Instead, even while we continue to be in bondage to sin, you revealed your love to us in Jesus. Use this love to transform our hearts. We ask this in Jesus’ name. Amen.

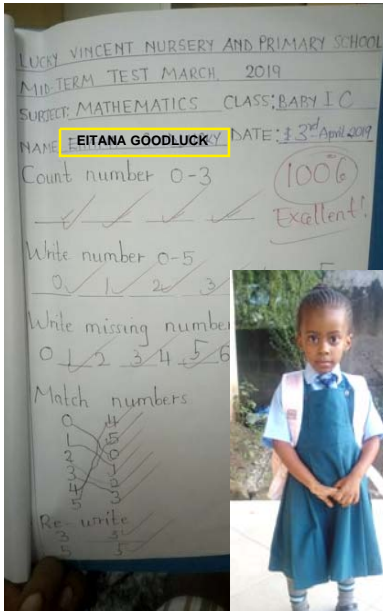
