Read: "Paul's Mission" (Acts 13:1-3, 14:8-18)

Recite: While they were worshiping the Lord and

fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." - Acts 13:2

Reflect:

- In the reading this week, we hear that "the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul (Paul) for the work to which I have called them" (Acts 13:2). The two had gifts and talents equipping them for that work. Who have you known in your life that felt particularly gifted for the work of ministry? How has their work touched you?
- One of the promises we hear in the writing of Saul (Paul) is that all of us are gifted in some way for the work of ministry and the building up of the body of Christ. What talents and gifts is God manifesting in your life these days for the work of that ministry?

Pray: God who calls and sends, your Holy Spirit is constantly calling to us. Some may be called to be pastors or preachers. Others may be called to positions of leadership and responsibility within the church. Some are gifted to be extravagantly generous givers. Others are called simply to be willing workers. Do not allow us to overlook that all are called. Equip us then to grow in faith and practice so we may respond in love and willingness to serve you and others. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
