Returning to Tanzania from Sharon Tissue

I have just returned from 18 days of basking in the love and hospitality of the families of New Life Band of Arusha, Tanzania. Having first been overwhelmed by their African style welcome at the airport it kept getting better and better as each of the band members invited us into their homes to meet their wives and children and to share a meal. Ginny Liljefelt, who traveled with me, and I have had a 22-year relationship with the NLB since they first got stranded in Lafayette in 1997. Will and I visited them in 1999 and met their wives and children but have only watched them grow up via photographs. It was a blessing to see them again, some grown and with their own children and to meet the families of the younger members of NLB. In the weeks ahead, I'd like to share the stories of those "Kids" and their families who received your support through HSLC's "Kids of NLB Scholarship Fund".

Before I do that, please let me introduce you to another aspect of NLB's Mission to Youth & Students: NLB CAMP which was held June 9-15th at Highlands Youth Camp, Morogoro, Tanzania (www.impactyouthworldwide.org) where about 1200 students (600 at a time) have traveled this week to hear the gospel. Students are bused in from several regions about 11 hrs travel time away for just a \$5.00 registration fee, made possible by support from the Highlands facility and churches throughout Tanzania. It is truly remarkable that a camp undertaking of this size can be organized and administrated by the 10 band members, families and friends! Asante sana for your prayers for the Camp's impact on the lives of the youth of Tanzania.
