
Bring your weed whackers, clippers, gloves and sunscreen. Come join us to keep our grounds looking beautiful during the summer. Coffee and donuts at 9:00


Another Challenge Grant for IHP! Christmas in July!! Dr. Christine Petersen is again offering a Christmas in July Challenge grant of \$15,000 to finish the Mary Ellen Kitundu Memorial Birthing Center.

The "sanitaries" as they're called out here need to be installed. We haven't bought them yet. Toilets 16pcs@560,000/T-shillings each=\$3,947.14 Sinks 20pcs@320,000/T-shillings each= \$2,819.38 Shower mixers 16pcs@200,000/T-shillings each= \$1,409.69 Angle valves 72 pcs@17,000/T-shillings each=\$539.20 Station chamber covers 32 pcs@60,000/T-shillings each=\$845.81

### Total is \$9,561.22 (Plus labor)
