The Last Pastoral Listening Post

At its recent national Assembly, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America declared itself a "Sanctuary Denomination" – meaning ours is a church which supports migrants and refugees in our communities through a variety of legal means. While this decision will have no direct impact on our congregation or the ministries we provide, we seek to be attentive to the questions and concerns which a number of HSLC members have raised concerning this declaration. Additionally – as we prepare for a series of national elections in 2020 – we know that questions about immigration, border security, refugees, illegal aliens and sanctuary spaces will be at the heart of political debate across our land.

Wednesday, November 6, at 9:30 a.m. and again at 7:00 p.m. in the Center for Ministry Conference Room - come and discuss 1) your thoughts and feelings regarding the current national debate about immigration and border security, 2) the particular challenge which we as Christians face regarding these matters, and 3) how our congregation might best respond to the ELCA's declaration that ours is a 'Sanctuary Denomination'.

Your donation of \$411.98 is at work helping right now to continue the finishing on the safe birthing center, installing the 'sanitaries' as they're called in Tanzania. Thank you. The big job that needs to be completed before the building can be opened is the wastewater treatment system that will cost about \$25,000.00. We'll be working on the fundraising for that.

Dr. Kayla Heidinger, a 3rd year Mayo resident in family practice examined 3-year old Hadya who was brought in because of fever and vomiting. Hadya was negative for malaria or typhoid but was very dehydrated. She was given anti-nausea medicine, fluids and oral rehydration salts and responded very well. She had a viral infection.

Twelve-year old Rehla had a runny nose and cough. She had allergies and a cold and received antihistamines and cough syrup. Dr. Sweta Pattanaik did her work-up.
