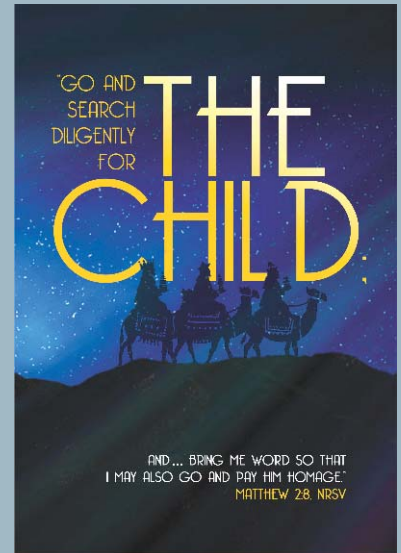

Dear Holy Shepherd Lutheran,

Your generous donation of \$1,450 for the mission of IHP is helping to continue the building and supporting the project in multiple ways. Thank you.

We're looking forward to seeing all of you on January 12, 2020. We'll have lots to update and share.

Engineers in both Tanzania and the U.S. Are working to find the bet design for a water reclamation system for the birthing center complex. In February or March

we'll have the final recommendation.

The construction crew is finishing up other projects already begun, i.e., the garage, the canteen and maternal and child health center. The Lofstrom guesthouse /home is almost done and we'll be moving into it in April when we return to Tanzania.

The crew is building low retaining walls around the gardens to protect them from flooding in the wet season.

You help to pay their salaries and to pay for the cement for the blocks.
