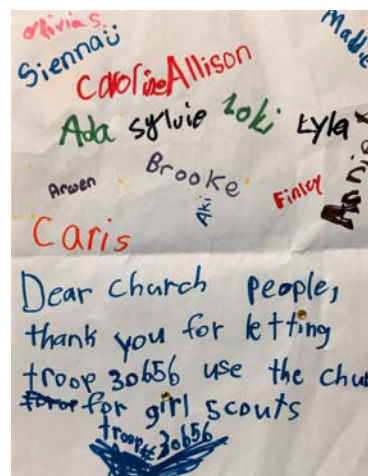

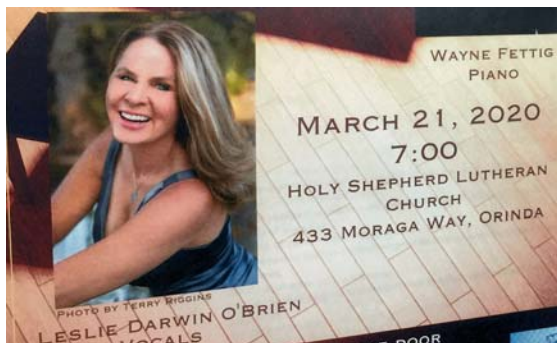


At home she enjoys watching cartoons, reading books, singing and dancing. May the God of heaven bless you with that wonderful loving heart for us.
