Community Ministry Update:

Holy Shepherd Community Preschool

There's a flurry of activity afoot on our campus as we make plans for the launch of Holy Shepherd Community Preschool in June of this year!

- Council Member Tom Gilbertson is coordinating construction planning with both architect Chris Gilman and contractor Todd Bifulco, and we are oh-so-close to finalizing final blueprint design plans and sending them off to plan-check.
- Vice-President Joan Kiekhaefer is orchestrating the blending of two organizational systems into one new entity, in conjunction with Pastor John, Amy Cabiles (our current Preschool Director) and Claire Peterson (the Executive Director of our new school structure.)
- Executive Director Claire Peterson reports that Holy Shepherd Community Preschool is fully-enrolled for both our 2023 Summer Session (40 students) and our 2023/24 Academic Year (54 students)! It appears we already have a waitlist for 2024!
- The Church Council took action to ensure that member-families of HSLC are accorded priority-access to registration in our new school, as a first step toward strengthening the connections between our church and school.

A Word from Pastor Pam

Ash Wednesday (February 22) marked the beginning of the season of Lent this year — and the beginning of our own personal Lenten journeys. Each of us may have our own, individual practice of spending time reflecting on Jesus' journey to the cross as we prepare ourselves for Holy Week and Easter. We may read a Lenten devotional book daily; we may write our thoughts and feelings in a journal; we may "give up" something; we may give special gifts of money or food or time to help those in need. There are many ways to set this time apart, to make it holy.

Lent is a time of attending to the sacrifice that Christ made for us and of hearing again with fresh ears the scripture that tells of his teaching and healing, and of the ways in which it upset the political and religious leaders of Jesus' day. As we go through these days, we are invited to reflect on our own words and actions throughout our daily lives and work. As we follow Jesus, as we seek to be his disciples, do we concern


ourselves more with the world and with what it thinks of us, or with doing Christ's work, whatever the cost?

I find the following prayer (known to some as the 'Holden Village Prayer' or the 'Good Courage Prayer') to be a particularly meaningful and appropriate prayer for this season of Lent. Perhaps you'll be able to find a way to incorporate it into your daily Lenten practice this year:

O God, you have called your servants to ventures of which we cannot see the ending, by paths as yet untrodden, through perils unknown. Give us faith to go out with good courage, not knowing where we go, but only that your hand is leading us and your love supporting us, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. (ELW, pg. 304)

Palm Sunday (April 2nd)
