▲ WORDS OF CONFESSION AND HOPE

- L: These days of Lent are days for us to pay special attention to Jesus' journey to the cross. They are days for us to hear the stories of people whom Jesus encountered along the way. And they are days for us to realize that we are those very people We think of someone like Peter.
- P: And we realize that we too are guilty of running away from our commitments.
- L: We think of someone like Judas.
- P: And we realize that we too are more interested in our own agendas than the agenda of our Lord.
- L: We think of someone like Pontius Pilate.
- P: And we realize that we too are tempted to choose easy answers rather than the right ones.
- L: We think of someone like Caiaphas.
- P: And we realize that we too are tempted to abuse what authority we've been given.
- L: We think of people like Mary and Mary Magdalene, the disciples and the crowd.
- P: And we realize that in their story we find our stories too.
- L: But most of all, we discover in Jesus' story in His giving Himself for us all that there is forgiveness of our sin, hope for our future and strength for our journeys.

THE LESSON Matthew 25:1-13

Jesus spoke this parable to his friends and followers: "Then the kingdom of heaven will be like this. Ten young women took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. When the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps.

As the bridegroom was delayed, all of them became drowsy and slept. But at midnight there was a shout, 'Look! Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' Then all those young women got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' THE SERMON

▲ OUR AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

The words of the ancient "Christ hymn" – as recorded in Philippians 2 – invite us to consider both who Jesus is and whom we are called to be.

As people of God, we find our hope and salvation in Christ Jesus our Lord, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death – even death on a cross. Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.

THE COMMUNION LITANY

L: In the breaking of bread and the sharing of the cup, Jesus offered his first followers peace and friendship, trust and forgiveness, the love and embrace of God - and Jesus offers those same gifts. For – on the night in which he was betrayed – our Lord Jesus took bread and gave thanks; broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Take and eat; this is my body, given for you.

Do this for the remembrance of me." Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks and gave it for all to drink, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin.
